 - Support small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), including Small Business Enterprises (SBEs), Women Business Enterprises (WBEs), Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBEs), and Minority Business Enterprises (MBEs), and promote community development, where possible.

 - Select suppliers who have demonstrated the ability to quickly adapt to new technologies and market changes.

 - Choose suppliers who have a track record of providing quality work that meets or exceeds regulatory standards.
